# Background of NIU

- 65 miles west of Chicago
- Total student population:20,130
  - Undergraduate: 15,027
    - Freshman: 1,802
    - Transfer:1,728
  - 43% Students of Color
  - 47% Pell Grant eligible
  - 53% First Generation
  - 90 % receive some type of financial aid

## 2016 Family Evaluations

- 96% of families said the videos helped them understand NIU resources.
- 99% of families said they will discuss the potential student life issues that could impact their student.
- 99% of families said the videos helped them understand what NIU expects of their student.
- 99% said they will discuss Shared Access with their student.



## 2015 Family Evaluations

- 79% of families said the videos helped them think about how student life issues could impact their student.
- 81% said the panel addressed their questions and concerns about student life at NIU.
- 88% of families said they are now able to identify ways to engage my student in conversations regarding healthy choices and strategies for reducing risk.
- 93% of families felt they are a ware of the resources available to help their student with any of the topics or issues discussed.
